Course Offerings:

1. Print Shop 101

Learn the terms and applications of printing. Students will set type and have the opportunity to operate several presses including a 1910 Potter Proof Press and an 1894 Chandler & Price Letterpress. Students can create business cards or note cards.

2. Knitting and Crocheting Basics

3. Introduction to Scrapbooking
